ADDITIONAL REQUIREMENTS

Should the animal be put to sleep or pass away during their stay with Critter Creche, please select your request from the following:-

The vet or Critter Creche to hold the pet in its cold store for collection when you return so that you may bury him/her.

Ask the vet to arrange a cremation of the pet (this does incur an additional cost from the vet).

Your pet to be buried here at Critter Creche.

Should your pet pass away unexpectedly do you want us to text you immediately to let you know.

Do you want us to text you the day before collection so that you may call us and discuss a suitable time for you to collect your pet.

TERMS & CONDITIONS

Payments are to be made on arrival, all cheques to be made payable to **J HUGHES**.

Please declare if your pet has any signs of illness or is pregnant. We reserve the right to refuse any very sick pets unless we have agreed to take them prior to arrival. We strongly advise that all bunnies are vaccinated against fatal diseases such as Myxomatosis and VHD. First time vaccinations should be done at least 28 days prior to boarding. We care for all boarders to the best of our ability and will not be held responsible for illnesses/infections.

E-cuniculi is a parasite - a small protozoan that lives inside the body cells of its host. It doesn't just infect rabbits: many other mammals (including humans in some special circumstances), and even birds can be infected. We recommend a yearly dose of Panacur, which is believed to help against this parasite. Please ask your vet about worming when you have their vaccinations, again this should be at least 28 days prior to boarding.

Owners must be aware that boarding can be a stressful period for some small animals. We will take every care to ensure that your pet's stay is as stress free as possible. However, very occasionally signs of illness can occur in usually healthy small animals as a result of boarding. We cannot be held responsible in the event of illness.

We are happy to house bonded animals of the same species together. However, animals are housed together at your own risk. We will not be held responsible for any fights between bonded animals housed together. If we see signs of fighting we reserve the right to separate the pair and the owner is liable for the additional charge for separate accommodation.

If your pet does show sign of illness whilst in our care and we are concerned for their welfare, we will first consult you/your emergency contact and then seek the advice of our local vet (the charges for a vet who your pet is not registered with may be more expensive). By leaving your pet in our care you are agreeing to pay any vet fees incurred by your pet on collection.

Sadly small animals can become ill and pass away with very little warning. We promise to take great care of your pet and will accept no liability in the unlikely event that your pet passes away whilst in our care.

Drop off and Collection are usually between the hours of 9.00am and 10.00am or 5.00pm and 6.00pm. If these times are not suitable please let me know and we can arrange another time. Please ensure that you deliver and collect your pet on the dates booked. If you cannot collect your pet on the date agreed prior, please contact us asap to inform us of the same. We would be grateful if you would contact us as soon as possible should you need to cancel or change your booking.

Parking - We are situated at the end of a small single track lane. It is recommended to reverse on our drive, which will make it easier for you when leaving. The gates are usually open during opening times. **Please do NOT park on the grass area where the garages are on the lane, this is private land!**

Critter Creche has **NO** public liability insurance and cannot be held responsible for loss or injury to pets left, all pets are left at their owners risk.

We reserve the right to eventually re-home your pet if it is not collected and no contact is made 1 week after the agreed collection date.
